


## National Catholic Education Conference





Teachers will have timers on and an alarm will go off at the 8-minute mark to indicate that the meeting needs to conclude.

- Year 3 Parents will be able to wait in the hall, whilst Year 4 6 parents will be able to wait outside the classrooms in the hallways.



## **VISIT FROM CALSHER DEAR**

Last week, we were fortunate to welcome Calsher Dear, Hawthorn Football Club player and big cousin to students Imogen & Alfie Camfield and Marlie Coombs, to speak with our Year 5 & 6 students.

Calsher shared what it is like to play football at the highest level and encouraged our students to reflect on how these lessons can also guide them in their learning and leadership at St Peter's.

Some of the key messages he left with us included:

- Just because you lose a game, it doesn't make you a loser it's about trying harder next time.
- If the opposition are trying to get into your head, don't let them. Show them you're better through your actions because actions speak louder than words.

His talk was both inspiring and practical, giving our students valuable reminders about resilience, focus, and character on and off the field.

On the 21st of August Hawthorn player Calsher Dear visited the Year 5's and 6's to talk about respect, resilience and teamwork. We also had a chance to ask questions about his football life and he kindly answered them. A big thanks to Mr Cavarra for organising Calsher Dear for coming in.




